Responsibilities:

- Conduct online and in-person Behavioral Health presentations to Upper Elem., Middle, and High School students
- Attend monthly facilitator meetings and all-staff meetings with Program Director and Executive Director
- Administer and collect pre and post surveys to students for data/impact collection

Requirements:

- Highly skilled communicator both written and verbally
- Bi-Lingual (Spanish) desired but not required.
- Must attend paid position training
- Quality time management skills, works well with deadlines and communicates openly and professionally.
- Experienced with Zoom, Google Meets, Microsoft Teams, and other virtual online platforms.
- Adept with Microsoft Office Suite
- Must have reliable transportation
