Eligibility and Application Information

- Domestic institutions that grant undergraduate (BS or BA) and/or graduate degrees in biomedical sciences
- Have received < \$6 million per year from [NIH Research Project Grants \(RPGs\)](#) in each of the preceding three fiscal years
 - **Enroll at least 35% of undergraduate students supported by Pell grants**
 - OR**
 - **Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) and Tribal Colleges and Universities (TCUs)**
