
RAY What is the RAY Fellowship Program?

WHO WE ARE

Named in honor of **Dr. Roger Arliner Young**, the first African American woman to receive a doctorate in zoology, the RAY Fellowship Program is a two-year paid fellowship managed by the **Environmental Leadership Program.** This fellowship is designed to equip early career professionals with the tools, experiences, support, and community they need to become leaders in the conservation and clean energy sectors.

Fellows have the chance to work at a clean energy or conservation organization in our network of partners for two-years.

IDEAL CANDIDATE

The RAY Fellowship Program looks for applicants who:

- Identify as a person from an underrepresented community, with an interest in the conservation and/or clean energy field(s).
- Be within THREE years of having received their undergraduate degree (May 2022- June 2025).
- Have not had a full-time job in conservation or clean energy.
- Demonstrate a commitment to environmental justice, and social change.
